How you can support your child in Key Stage 4



Make sure your child is well prepared

- Uniform
- Equipment
- Diary

Use the diary

- Check homework is recorded and completed
- Sign it on a Thursday
- Write me a message or ask a question



Space to work

- Desk, paper, highlighters
- Well lit
- Limit distractions (mobile phones, ipods, Facebook, etc.)



Homework

- 2 hours per evening
- Never accept "I do not have homework"!
- Check that it is done
- Check that it is put in their school bag



Revision

- Regular revision rather than cramming
- Organise revision: have a timetable, take a short break after 35 minutes, have a notebook or file for each subject
- Use different revision techniques reading your notes or a textbook is <u>not</u> revision.
- Think about using: mindmaps, cards, posters, summaries, key bullet points, explain what you have learnt to a family member, write your own test, colour codes, etc.
